What Will Children Wear?

Even though it is not compulsory to wear a uniform in Nursery we do encourage this to foster a sense of belonging to the school. Our school uniform consists of maroon sweatshirt or cardigan and grey pants or grey or tartan skirt/pinafore, with either white or maroon polo shirts (maroon stay cleaner for longer). Children can also wear summer gingham dresses or shorts in summer. Uniform can be purchased from Rainbows or JayMax in Leigh or Icon on Market Street, Atherton.

Also, please provide spare clothing, in case of accidents or following messy activities, including spare socks and underwear. The spares can be kept in a bag in class or sent in their daily bag.

Please label all items of clothing clearly with your child's name (using name labels or permanent marker) including their coat, bag and shoes.







What Will Children Need?

Children will need a suitable coat at all times as we access our outdoor provision constantly throughout the day and in different types of weather. Please also consider any other items of clothing suitable for the weather e.g. hats, gloves and scarf or sun hat, if appropriate.

Children will need to bring a book bag with them to school daily, this will help them with carrying letters, books and pictures home each day. This should either be the maroon Parklee school bag, or a similar sized bag of their colour choice to be able to fit on a peg.

All children will need to bring a labelled water bottle daily containing water (as per school policy). We can then refill this when needed and send it home each night.

<u>PE Uniform:</u>

- Red T shirt
- Black Tracksuit: including joggers or leggings and black zip up top.
- Trainers (or pumps ideally Velcro fastening for the younger children)

Children will come to school dressed in PE kit on their PE day and will stay in it all day. Appropriate PE kits can be bought from any store but if you wish to purchase the school's badged tracksuit as seen in our pictures with initials these can be purchased at the stockist uniform shops as above. <u>PE days will be confirmed at a later</u> <u>date.</u>

What Will Children Eat?

<u>Snack</u>

Children in Nursery have access to a daily snack in the morning and fresh fruit throughout the day along with milk. We kindly ask for a 50p donation each day your child attends to cover the costs of this and allow us to provide more varied snack options. This can be paid weekly or half-termly via bank transfer (details of banks to follow).

If your child is staying for full days we have two options for lunch time. If you wish for your child to have a hot dinner provided by school these are £1.95 each. Dinners must be ordered electronically at home. (Please refer to the separate letter for lunches which will help you in being able to be set up with 'Evolve' our provider to order your child's lunches from home). Alternatively, please feel free to send your child in with a packed lunch if they would prefer. We are a completely nut-free school so please avoid sending any foods containing nuts, including nut chocolate spreads.

Class Dojo is a communication app which we use across school. It allows us to share letters and information about school and provides a secure messaging service between teachers and parents. We will use it to send as much information to you as necessary throughout the year (it also allows us to be eco-friendlier). Each child has a little monster and they can earn 'monster points' throughout their day. When children receive a set number of 'monster points', they will receive a prize as a positive reward. Please ensure that you have provided school with your current email address so that we can connect you to this app, therefore you will not miss any upcoming events or essential news and letters.
